‘Gifts’ plural because there are different anointings for different ailments.

R.W. Schambach (1926–2012)

was a prominent American Pentecostal evangelist and televangelist known for his "miracle" crusades, fiery preaching style, and faith-healing ministry. He co-founded Schambach Ministries to promote the gospel through media and crusades, advocating a message of "power" to overcome, famously urging believers to "put the devil in his place".

Why could Jesus heal everyone that came to Him?

For He whom God has sent speaks the words of God, for God does not give the Spirit by measure. The Father loves the Son, and has given all things into His hand. He who believes in the Son has everlasting life; and he who does not believe the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him.”

What about the word healings?

And it came to pass on a certain day, as he was teaching, that there were Pharisees and doctors of the law sitting by, which were come out of every town of Galilee, and Judaea, and Jerusalem: and the power of the Lord was present to heal them.

But when Jesus knew it, He withdrew from there. And great multitudes followed Him, and He healed them all.

“The anointing is a transference of God's Spirit, favor and power upon a person to enable him to perform a specific duty or purpose”.
